





Metro Tunnel: Anzac Station

- 40,000 people daily by 2031
- Access to 33,000 jobs and 17,000 residents within 800 metres by 2031
- Constructed via a 'cut and cover' technique
- 5 year construction program

- Drop off and taxi zones near Albert Road Reserve


Domain Precinct Master Plan

- City of Port Phillip project
- Public Realm Plan works to the public area, not changes to planning controls for private development
- Council is currently seeking feedback on the "Design Response" – a plan that incorporates comments from earlier consultation. Comments accepted until 29 May 2019.

Domain Precinct: Park Street Link

- Tram Link between Kings Way and Moray
- Trams from St Kilda Road to Clarendon and Spencer Streets
- Bike link across Kings Way
- Replant trees





Domain Precinct: Kings Way Reserve Upgrade

- Increase open space close Queens Road to Kings Way
- Provide visual and sound barrier
- Additional landscaping
